- ** ALL SAFETY GEAR BOOTS, ARMOUR, HELMET, GLOVES MUST BE WORN WHILE AT THIS EVENT
- ** FIRST GEAR IN THE PITS AND TO START GATE
- ** No tear-offs are to be used
- ** NO 250cc 2 strokes for students.... Supporters can ride what they like.
- ** NOTE: Please make sure you are placed in the appropriate class. Beginner class is for riders who have very little experience on trail and track.
